Context ONE ON ONE TIME WITH MAURICE LOOKING AT A PICTURE OF A CAT PET BY ROSIE	Looking Back Do you remember when you saw Big Cat at the Petit Refuge for the first time?	Looking Here / Closely Why do you think the cat is so comfortable with Rosie?	Looking Beyond How could we redesign the Petit Refuge to be more welcoming to cats?
Context PIERRE QUI ROULE, LOOKING AT A ROTTEN PUMPKIN AND A DRIED ONE	Looking Back What rotten fruits or vegetables have you seen before?	Looking Here / Closely What do you notice? How are the pumpkins different? alike?	Looking Beyond What could we do next time to prevent the pumpkin from rotting?
Context MAURICE, EXPECTING MORE SNOW	Looking Back When is the last time you played in snow?	Looking Here / Closely Tell me about what you see. What are you measuring. What were you hoping for?	Looking Beyond How could we still have a memorable day? What would cheer you up?
